- (2) *Percentage - Total number of chronically homeless divided by the total number of people sheltered and unsheltered (does not include transitional housing numbers).*

Of the 22 continua in the Balance of State, one 1 has reported no chronically homeless numbers during the last 3 PIT counts – Ozaukee.
