<u>Vote on PSH standards:</u> Motion by Byron to approve the PSH standards as revised. Second by Carrie. After discussion, Byron amended his motion to approve with clarification on 5 year record retention requirement. Carrie seconded the amendment. Motion carried.

<u>Application update:</u> Still waiting for a couple of project applications to come in. Robyn made the recommendation that when the next round comes due the persons responsible for writing each project's application get together for a day and go through the app line by line. Carrie and Robyn will be meeting to work on the collaborative application and the planning grant on January 18th. They will share the pdf with the rest of the board.

<u>TH scoring rubric:</u> Carrie proposed that points be based on the High-Risk-Pool score, the ranking in the CoC competition, the recidivism rate and answers to the narrative questions on experience/capacity, case management and mainstream resources, and HUD performance measures. She is looking for suggestions on how to incorporate a measure for audits.
